



# UNDERSTANDING BRECKLAND COUNCIL'S LOCAL PLAN REVIEW

Breckland Council is currently reviewing its Local Plan, which is the document that sets out where new homes, jobs, and services should be located across the district over the coming years. This process is called the Regulation 18 Draft Local Plan stage.

At this stage, the Council is asking for views on potential development sites, planning policies, and future growth options. It's an important early opportunity for residents, parish councils, and local organisations to have their say before any final decisions are made.

Once all comments have been reviewed, the Council will move to the next stages:

<u>2026 – Regulation 19 Stage</u>: A more detailed and formal version of the Local Plan will be published. This will include the Council's preferred sites and policies. There will be another chance for public comment, though this stage is more focused on whether the plan meets national planning requirements.

<u>2027 – Examination and Adoption</u>: The final plan will be submitted to a Government Planning Inspector for examination. If approved, it will be formally adopted by Breckland Council and guide planning decisions for years to come.



#### THE GARDEN IN DECEMBER



It is hard to second guess the weather. It used to be simple – December was cold following a cool, wet, and sometimes frosty November. The grass

had stopped growing and the lawnmower was oiled and put away until the Spring. What you do in the garden this month is very much determined by the weather.

**Outside taps.** Turn them off from indoors if you can, if not insulate them.

**Perennials** that die back to nothing each year can be cut down to the ground, but if there are any seedheads leave them for the tits and finches and cut them back later. Keep short plants free from piles of leaves to prevent rot getting into the crown.

**Lawns**. When weather permits mow with blades set to about 5 cm high which reduces the risk of disease but gives some protection from very cold weather. If you are encouraging wildflowers cut a little higher.

Trees and shrubs (including roses) Continue to plant bare root trees, shrubs and hedges when the ground is not frozen. Stake taller plants to prevent rocking in the wind. Check ties from time to time and re-firm the earth if necessary.

**Cuttings.** Hardwood cuttings can still be taken.

**Vegetables** Continue to harvest whatever is ready. Support taller brussels sprout plants.

Fruit Continue winter pruning of fruit trees (not stone fruit) and bushes until mid-February. Finish pruning grape vines by the end of the month. Keep some 30 cms lengths of woody prunings, cut at an angle just below a bud and straight across just above a bud (this way you will know which way up to plant them). Plant several in a large pot or cuttings bed and keep watered through the summer and they will be ready to plant out next autumn.

Winter prune established blackcurrant bushes. They fruit best on strong young growth, so remove thick old growth at the base to leave a structured open bush. (Note: Red currants and white currants fruit on older growth, so only prune for shape).

Plant rhubarb between now and late February. Dig in plenty of well-rotted manure or compost and plant with the crown just below the surface.

**Bulbs** It is not too late to plant daffodil and tulip bulbs. Check potted bulbs planted in September and move any that are ready to an unheated greenhouse, cold frame, or <u>cool</u> windowsill.

**Wildlife** keep feeders topped up and a water source (birds still need to drink when it is icy, so check bowls and replenish regularly).

Don't turn compost heaps in cold conditions as it might disturb hibernating grass snakes, slow worms, or hedgehogs.

If you have any fallen fruits that are still laying on the ground, they can be left if they are not causing a problem – the birds and small mammals will be glad of them if it turns cold.

**Plan and dream.** Seed catalogues are available online now. Why not try something new next year. Seeds make a thoughtful and inexpensive gift – perfect for a secret Santa (choose a variety to match the character of the recipient – soft, sunny, prickly, cabbage looking???)!

Here are some books you may be interested in trying, and here's hoping you get some book tokens over the Christmas



period to enjoy some of these. They may not all be to your taste, but they are certainly a mixed bag. All books are available in hard copy/audio books.

#### <u> Ultra-Processed People – Chris van Tulleken</u>

This book was recommended by a friend who knows me well and my interest in nutrition. All I can say is as interesting as it is, it is not an easy read by any stretch and took me several goes to finish it. Worth the read though if you can skip some of the more technical information.

The basis of the book is to really understand what you are eating every day. If you are for instance finding it hard to lose weight, it's not you it's the food you choose to eat. I'd have thought that was obvious!

Ultra- processed food which is industrially processed and marketed food is made to be addictive, whether it is by adding extra sugar, salt, or extra flavourings.

I had thought I had a healthy regime- not until I read this book. Bread is a great example, whether purchased from a supermarket shelf or bakery, there are substances that have been added to make them more appealing to you. This book has lots of accolades given to it, but you as the reader need to decide early on if you have the stamina to read it and change your ways. It most certainly is food for thought.

It is worth reading them in order if you like them, as characters from this first book turn up again in the last book of the Destiny series.

To everyone else, it looked like Samantha and David had the perfect life. From meeting at university and falling in love to starting a successful business together, they made a great team. However, as everybody knows, appearances can be deceptive. I just couldn't put this book down and found it very addictive, finishing at 04.00am once morning! Such a great read.

November 11th marked Armistice Day, commemorated each year to recognise the Armistice signed

between the Allies of World War I and Germany. That agreement took effect at 11am - the "eleventh hour of the eleventh day of the eleventh month" of 1918. After the death of his beloved father, Arthur and a group of other young evacuees are sent far away to Canada for their own safety on the eve of the Second World War. Alone and afraid, with no family to protect him, Arthur faces an unknown future.

But even on the other side of the world he can't escape the war. Faced with more upheaval, Arthur begins to doubt he will ever find his forever family. With so much heartache and turmoil, can he hold on to his dream of love and happiness? It really is a great read.
